Submission Guidelines

What is H.E.ART?

High-schoolers Expressing ART Gallery is a charity project run by 3 entrepreneurial juniors in the Bellevue School District. This project features a short-term pop-up gallery in various venues such as Crossroads Mall. The gallery showcases student artwork with a selling period where art is available for purchase in person and online through our website. All proceeds will be donated through the Bellevue Schools Foundation to support Bellevue School District art programs.

How can you participate?

H.E.ART Gallery is looking to showcase various mediums of art with the overarching theme of: Journey. Create a work of art showcasing the theme using any artistic medium or materials that abide by our guidelines and submit your art to H.E.ART for review. Submissions must be received by **March 22nd, 2019** for artwork to be displayed in 2019's H.E.ART Gallery Show in May.

Theme: JOURNEY

Create a work of art that embodies the theme of a journey. Will it relate to your life journey? Or is it a journey to a particular place? Will your piece depict something that related to a moment of that journey or will it show a process? Is it a fantasy adventure that you've dreamed of or an expedition to a foreign land?

Submission Requirements

1. Student's full name and phone number must located on the back left corner of their art and title card must be completed.
2. Artist must be a high school student in the Bellevue School District.
3. Entry form and photographs of artwork must be fully completed and submitted to either the physical art bins at their respective schools or emailed to H.E.ART by Friday, March 22nd, 2019.
4. Art cannot include profanity, weaponry, gore, nudity, or anything else deemed inappropriate for school and public display.
5. Art cannot be plagiarized and must be original work.
6. Copyrighted images, characters, or brand identities are prohibited from being displayed.

Submission Requirements for Specific Mediums:

Photo or Digital Art Prints: Entrant must be the photographer or original artist and may use a variety of digital editing techniques to enhance their image. Images must be printed on matte or glossy photo paper (supplied by the artist). Print must be 300 DPI or higher. Print dimensions must be between 4" x 6" and 20" x 30".

Canvas Work: The following art mediums must be sealed in a bag or casing: chalk or pastel, oil pastels, charcoal, and conte crayon. All oil paintings must be completely dry. Canvas dimensions must be no larger than 40" x 40". It is strongly advised that your canvas sides are painted or have clean edges. Work must be ready to mount.

All other 2D: The following art mediums must be sealed in a bag or casing: chalk or pastel, oil pastels, charcoal, and conte crayon. Quality paper appropriate to the chosen medium must be used, thin or printer paper may not be displayed. Works must be no larger than 40" x 40". All art must be mounted on mat board or heavy poster board when submitted. Artists may use their discretion to determine the mat color that best compliments their work.

Ceramics: All ceramics must be fired work. Work must be no larger than 1 cubic foot. Bubble wrap, clean paper, and/or foam pieces should be used to safely and completely package ceramics for transportation. All glazes used must be AP (non-toxic). Please specify in your artists statement if your work is food safe. If you are unsure whether or not your art meets food-safe requirements please contact the H.E.ART. Team or your high school art teacher.

All other 3D: Other 3D art may include: origami, sculptures, metal work, stained glass, jewelry, woodwork, fabric works, etc. Small fragile works (jewelry, origami, etc.) must be carefully wrapped in tissue or butcher paper and/or bubble wrap, or placed in their own box. Bubble wrap, clean paper, and/or foam pieces should be used to safely and completely package larger works for transportation.

Contact the H.E.ART Team with concerns regarding packaging and transportation to find alternatives. Works must be no larger than 1 cubic foot.
